CONSENT AGENDA:

Approval of the April 16, 2024, BEDC Regular Meeting minutes: Board Member Ricky Langley moved to approve the consent agenda as presented. Board Member Brad Zehner seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

ACTION ITEMS:

<u>Discuss and consider action: Related to the potential sale of all or portions of the Crossings at 281 South Commercial Park:</u> Board Member David Vaughn updated all present that the hangar project is currently underway. The LOMR has also been submitted. Updates to Houston Clinton and the veterinary clinic will need to be completed by a contractor. No action was taken.

<u>Discuss</u> and consider action: Related to the sale of all or portions of the Eastside Commercial Park located on <u>Highway 29 East:</u> Board Member David Vaughn reported that the Tractor Supply project continues to make great progress. The opening date has been tentatively scheduled for September 2024. No action taken.

Discuss and consider action: Related to the potential sale of all or portions of 118 E. Polk Street (Old Bealls Building) and 102 E. Polk Street (Kroeger Strip Center): Board Member David Vaughn reported that an email has been received with the final paperwork for the tank removal. The removal project is now considered complete. The board discussed possible options for the property. No action was taken.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Related to the Coke Street Re-Alignment Project:</u> Board Member David Vaughn confirmed that a meeting was held to discuss the realignment. Currently, there is still much to be determined, such as the cost of the project. No action taken.
