

RESOLUTION R2022-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TX, AUTHORIZING THE BURNET POLICE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY AND ACCEPT A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (OPERATION SLOW DOWN) GRANT.

**Whereas,** the Texas Department of Transportation offers a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program grant in an amount up to \$10,000; and

**Whereas,** the grant would provide funding for additional Officers during June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 through June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022; and

**Whereas,** the Burnet Police Department is eligible for the grant in an amount up to \$10,000; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS:**

**Section 1. Findings.** That the City Council of the City of Burnet, Texas authorizes the Burnet Police Department to apply for and receive a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (OPERATION SLOW DOWN) Grant in the amount up to \$10,000. The City of Burnet will provide a 20% match (\$2,000).

**Section 2. Open Meetings.** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code*.
