

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 106-56., ARTICLE THREE, OF THE CODE ORDINANCES; REGULATING THE OPERATION AND PARKING OF VEHICLES ON LEAGUE STREET; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY, AND AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City to provide, from time to time, such changes in traffic regulations as are appropriate to current traffic patterns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings: The preceding recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amendments:

Amend Section 106-56 in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 106-56. Parking on portions of League Street.

It shall be unlawful to park a motor vehicle or trailer on the north side of League Street between a point 30 feet east of Highway 281 to the railroad track situated between South Boundary Street and South Silver Street.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications hereof which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the *Tex. Loc. Gov't. Code*.

Section 5. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code*.
